CAROLYN HARRIS MP STANDING UP FOR SWANSEA EAST



July is always a month I look forward to, as with the advent of the summer recess away from Westminster comes the longest stretch of time I get to spend in our community working on #EveryoneDeservesASummer. This month saw plenty of action in the Commons chamber, be it on gambling or menopause, but I would be lying if I said I didn't have an eye on things back home in Swansea East and all the good causes my team are working with. Have a lovely summer all!

## A Busy Month in the Chamber

I was fortunate enough to be once again drawn for PMQs (I'm on a hot streak) and I took the opportunity to question the Deputy Prime Minister, Oliver Dowden, on the progress the Government was making with the Gambling White Paper. The question came days after the coroner found that the cause of Luke Ashton's tragic suicide in April 2021 was gambling disorder, a significant finding in a landmark case for those who have campaigned for reform of the industry. Immediately before Luke's death and bombarded with inducements, he placed over 1200 bets with no intervention from the operator. I was relieved to hear that as a former Secretary of State for the Department of Culture, Media and Sport, the Deputy PM 'shares [my] concerns about gambling inducements' but I still fear the White Paper does not go far enough to curb advertising and promotions.

I carried this train of thought into DCMS questions on the 20<sup>th</sup>, where I explained to the Secretary of State that with 55,000 young people aged 11-16 already classed as problem gamblers, and tens of thousands more considered at risk, it should be obvious to everyone that loot boxes in video games are a slippery slope towards gambling disorder.

It wouldn't be a month in Parliament without me bringing up menopause and the Government's atrocious handling of HRT shortages on the floor of the House and July was no exception. I explained to the Minister responsible for women's health that I have had thousands of women contact me, detailing just how disruptive the shortages of Utrogestan have been. Many women in England have paid for the HRT Pre-Payment Certificate I successfully campaigned for, in order to receive their HRT prescriptions at a reduced rate, only to find their chosen product in short supply and be provided an alternative that isn't covered by the PPC, meaning they are charged twice.
